We need your help

Anderton Memorial Hall requires extensive restoration or rebuilding.

The kitchen needs replacing.

The heating is insufficient and costly to operate.

Birds are building nests in the roof space, and the roof leaks.

The overflowing downpipes are deteriorating the car park.

The land the hall stands on has been conveyed for local use, but it is not listed on the Land Registry.

Unless the Parish Council owns the Land Registry, the building cannot be demolished and rebuilt. Although we have a tight budget, grants are available if we can overcome the Land Registry obstacle.

The Parish Council requires suitably qualified legal advice – would anyone in the village be able to help or know someone who can?



Hopyards Bridge needs to be replaced

Although they lack the funding to build the bridge, Cheshire West & Chester (CWAC) has agreed to assume ownership of any new bridge.

It is estimated that the bridge will cost £35,000.

The Friends of Anderton and Marbury (FoAM) are attempting to obtain grants totalling approximately £22,000.

As the bridge is the safest foot route between Anderton and Marbury should the Parish Council use funds to help, or is there another way to raise money?
