

## ANDERTON WITH MARBURY PARISH COUNCIL

The Chairman opened the meeting at 7pm

- 1) Councillors Bullock, O Hynes, R Hynes, Green, Walmsley and Wright were present with apologies from Cllr Byram and CWAC councillors Wright, Hammond and Gibbon.
- 2) Declarations of interest  
As all councillors lived in the vicinity of the village they all had personal interests.
- 4) Minutes of Meeting held on 27 November 2017  
*Resolution 1 08.01.2018 : Council approved the minutes of the meeting held on 27 November 2017 as being a true record of that meeting.*

- 5) Clerks report
  - The gardener would be asked to trim the hedge along the hall carpark unless Cllr Wright could make alternative arrangements with Mr Whalley.
  - Northwich Transport Strategy consultation- the Chairman had attended the CWAC full council meeting on 14 December to put the parish council's views forward in a short submission. There were views for and against re opening Marbury Lane but councillors were opposed to a road running around the north of Barnton to Little Leigh. A route via Weaverham to the A49 was favoured. A further meeting might be necessary after the consultation had closed.
  - The Clerk had written to the parliamentary boundary commission supporting the recommendation that Anderton with Marbury should join Weaver Vale.
  - The Clerk had contacted the Barnton Clerk re water runoff from Gunnersclough Wood affecting Hough Lane. The issue had been resolved.
